week. Intercede for them as they apply God's Word to the lives of their hearers.

21 Pastors and their wives gather at *The Lodge* this week for a Pastors' Retreat. Please ask God to greatly refresh and bless these dear couples as our staff ministers to them.

22 Pray that as our ministry leaders gather for Leadership Development meetings, they would grow in their responsibilities and skills for God's glory.

23 Jimmy Herdklotz serves as the Director of Life Action Camp. Pray for him and Lori today as they coordinate all the aspects of this summer's Family Camps as well as prepare for Staff Training.
